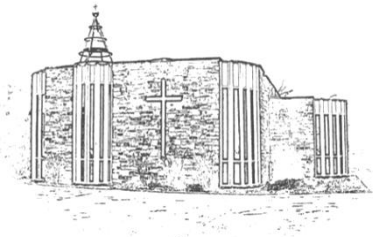
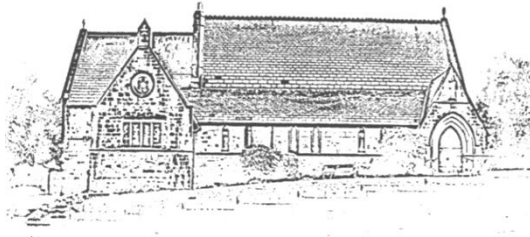


Parishes of Harden and Wilsden

Lent Appeal. This year Easter is not the earliest it can be, but nevertheless Lent does seem to have arrived hard on the heels of Epiphany. The Mission Support group is again asking the parishes to concentrate their giving during Lent on the work of the Church Mission Society. There will be boxes available to use throughout the season. CMS mission partners work in many places, in the UK and overseas, often at the request of local churches. We have undertaken to support the work of Awais Mughal who is working for social justice by helping asylum seekers and refugees in Leeds to improve their language skills. Many of these people have come from horrendous situations and although safer now, are feeling lost in their new surroundings. Please pray for Awais and give generously to enable CMS to continue with this and similar work wherever it is needed.
