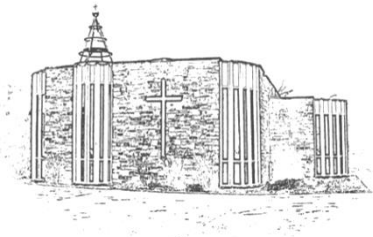
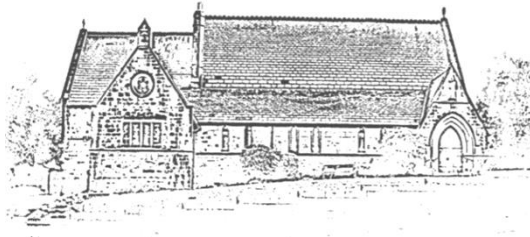


# Parishes of Harden and Wilsden

**Safeguarding Training.** Safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults is so important that everyone in the church should have an understanding of it. The Church of England now has training that is accessible on line and encourages everyone to take the opportunity to find out more.

On-line there is a Basic Awareness course which is suitable for all and a Foundation course which is required for all who have contact with children or young people or with vulnerable adults. A link to the course page is available on the parish website. You will need to register and you will then receive an email with a link to the courses. Once you have completed one of them you will be able to print out a certificate. It may sound complicated, but it isn't.

Face to face courses are available around our diocese. Details are available on the church notice board.

David Haigh, the parish safeguarding officer, will be encouraging those who have contact with children or vulnerable adults to complete a suitable course and will hope to see certificates!
