In addition to the 6th April event, there are collecting boxes in both churches to make the most of this opportunity. Women's World Day of Prayer 2019 will be celebrated on Friday 1st March. This year our local service will be at Trinity Church, Wilsden at 2pm led by Rev. Christine Crabtree. Men and women are both welcome. On this special day those taking part are encouraged to become aware of other countries and cultures, to sympathize with their problems and to pray with and for them. They are further encouraged to recognise their own talents and use them in the service of society.

Lent 2019 After positive feedback in 2018 outline plans are now in place for Churches Together Lent discussion groups. These will run for five weeks, from week beginning 11th March, with a final joint session at St Saviour's after the Wednesday evening service in Holy Week. The groups will follow a study guide "Lent with Luke". There are three possible daytime slots: Monday afternoon in Harden, Wednesday morning in St John's, or Thursday morning in Denholme (with lunch!) Also two possible evenings: Thursday in St. John's or Wednesday in Wilsden. If you would like to be involved and meet with members of other churches please sign the sheet at the back of church asap indicating the times that would be possible for you. Volunteers are also needed to act as hosts in Harden and Wilsden, not necessarily for the whole period.

New Electoral Rolls All church members, old and new, are encouraged to include their names on the new Roll. You will need to complete a form, available in church, and return it to the relevant electoral roll officer: Dorothy Senior at St. Matthew's, Gary Dickinson at St. Saviour's (or Malcolm Jones.)

The deadline is 21st March for Wilsden and 31st March for Harden.

The Electoral Roll is now covered by the GDPR Regulations, so a completed Data Consent Form is also needed.

Moon Landing The interior of Ripon Cathedral is to be filled with son et lumiere, (sound and light) as part of a series of events designed to commemorate 50 years since a man first stood on the moon. Projections of the solar system will fill the building accompanied by a rendition of Holst's The Planets on the magnificent Lewis Organ during the event on 15th March.

The cathedral's ancient interior will be used as the canvas for a series of film projections inspired by 'time and space' set to a soundtrack of choral pieces sung by the cathedral's lay clerks (adult singers), readings, organ music and soundscapes. Ripon Cathedral is also hosting a planetarium on 23^{rd} February as part of Nidderdale Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty's Dark Skies Festival. This will feature 360 degree technology and an immersive digital walk-through of the International Space Station with Tim Peake.
