The clergy, ministry team and pastoral team are always ready to respond to calls for help and support, whether it be food, prayer or a chat. **GORDON BASTOW**_Gordon was an active member of St. Matthew's for many years, serving God and the church faithfully throughout that time. Such service extended into the village and local community.

He was churchwarden at St Matthew's on several occasions, which added up to a total of 36 years, serving alongside a number of incumbents. It's hardly surprising he became known as Gordon the Warden, not just to those in church but to people further afield. His deep faith was lived out in many practical ways as he participated willingly in church activities both in Wilsden and in joint events with Harden. He loved making things and turned his hand to all sorts, including replacing the roof on the boiler room at St Matthew's. He used his skills to draw the initial plans of the present St Matthew's church and more recently to draw up plans for the memorial garden next to the church.

His love of walking and his easy rapport with people of all ages were true gifts. When he led the Pathfinders youth group in walks on the Moors, they would act out Bible stories, creating special memories for those young people. In more recent years, others remember him for helping with catering for WOT, worship on Tuesday, the forerunner of Messy Church.

He will be remembered as a kind, caring man, frequently combining an encouraging and reliable presence with the gift of brightening encounters as his sense of humour broke through. As we give thanks for Gordon's friendship and his steadfast witness to his faith over the years, we hold Jean, Ruth and all who miss him in our prayers. **Gordon's funeral** will be at St. Matthew's on Thursday 9 July at 1.30pm.
